

# **Basilit Curattack**

## **(Ready to use)**

**Description:** **Basilit Curattack** is an emulsion intended for the curative treatment and protection of structural and construction timber from attacks by insect larvae and fungi by spraying or injection. The product is also suitable for the treatment of dry rot (by injection into the walls).  
**Basilit Curattack** is ready to use.

**Authorisations and approvals:**

- Certificate of approval awarded by the A.B.P.B., no. D1/D2 35/710
- Authorisation of the Ministry of Public Health and the Environment: 496B.

**Characteristics:**

- Active ingredients: fungicide: propiconazole/insecticide: cypermethrin
- Product in aqueous phase.
- Product prepared using 120 gr of concentrate /litre.
- Good powers of penetration by spraying or sprinkling.
- Colourless.
- Slight odour.
- Product non-inflammable.

**Utilisation:**

**1) Treatment of roofing framework - ceilings – miscellaneous woodwork (Process D1)**

- Dust the wood
- Eliminate worm-eaten wood by hacking.
- Sprinkle all surfaces of the sprayer abundantly.
- Against attack by Carpicorn beetle larvae, proceed by injections (drilling diameter 12 mm, at intervals of 20 - 25 cm)
- **Consumption:** 0.3 - 0.5 L per m<sup>2</sup>

**2) Treatment of dry rot (Process D2)**

- Stip all affected masonry, including a 1 m security zone.
- Eliminate or destroy all affected woodwork.
- Clean walls with iron brush.
- Drill staggered holes every 25 cm to a depth equivalent to 2/3 of the thickness of the masonry
- Spray (approximately 1 litre per m<sup>2</sup>).
- **Consumption:**  
By injection: 5 litres of product per m<sup>2</sup> (for a wall 35 cm thick)  
By spraying: approximately 1 litre per m<sup>2</sup> of wall.

**Do not plaster the walls over fresh product!**

**After treatment:** After drying of the product, the wood may be decorated with any type of commercial product.

**Precautions**

**during application:**

- Avoid contact with eyes.
- Keep out of reach of children.
- Keep away from food and beverages.
- Read the label carefully before utilisation.
